CHAINS

A fir, 54 ins. diam., bears S.43*W., 149 lks. dist.,
marked T 31 S R 1 E S 19 B T.

A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.13*W., 108 lks. dist.,
marked T 31 S R 1 E S 18 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, clay loam and rocky, 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, and cedar.

Undergrowth, vine maple and rhododendron.

40.00 S.89*57'E., on a random line, bet. secs. 17 and 20,
Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
79.78 Intersect N. and S. line, 14 lks. S. of the cor. of secs.
16, 17, 20, and 21.

Thence

S.89*57'W., on a true line, bet. secs. 17 and 20.

Over mountainous land, through scattering burnt timber
and dense undergrowth.

Ascend 350 ft. over SE. slope.

21.90 Leave burn; enter green timber, bears N. and S.
35.70 Trail, bears NE. and SW.
39.89 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in
the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.60*W., 110 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 17 B T.

A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears S.82*W., 57 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 20 B T.

Ascend 80 ft. to

51.30 Divide bet. Umpqua and Rogue Rivers, bears NE. and SW.;
descend 60 ft. over NW. slope.

58.98 Brook, 1 lk. wide, course N.; ascend 120 ft.

71.00 Trail, bears N. and S.
