A dead fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.24*W., 36 lks.

dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 17 B T.

No living trees available for bearing trees and no stones available for mound.

Descend 25 ft. to

43.72 Brook, 1 lk. wide, course N.; ascend 75 ft. to

51.50 Spur, slopes N.; descend 275 ft. over W. slope to

77.82 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course N.

79.92 The cor. of secs. 7, 8, 17, and 18.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, clay loam and rocky, 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, and cedar.

Undergrowth, vine maple and rhododendron.

N.89*59'W., on a random line, bet. secs. 7 and 18,

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.41 Intersect W. bay. of the Tp., 33 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 7 and 18.

Thence

N.89*47'E., on a true line, bet. secs. 7 and 18.

Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

Ascend 480 ft. over SW. slope.

15.64 Spur, slopes NW.

Leave green timber; enter burn, bears NW. and SE.

Continue over rolling N. slope.

40.41 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked
