

Subdivisions of T. 31 S., R. 1 E.

CHAINS

N.89*41'E., on a true line, bet. secs. 6 and 7.

Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

Ascend 550 ft.

8.50 Foot of bluff, 40 ft. high, bears NW. and SE.

10.75 Top of same, bears NW. and SE.; enter burn and scattering timber, bears NW. and SE.

28.50 Spur, slopes S.; descend 50 ft. to

40.50 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap marked

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N.12*E., 55 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S 6 B T.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S.13*W., 47 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S 7 B T.

Descend 230 ft.

55.50 Enter green timber, bears N. and S.

57.25 Creek, 6 lks. wide, course SW.; ascend 130 ft. over SW. slope.

62.00 Bluff, 30 ft. high, bears NW. and SE.

67.75 Bluff, 60 ft. high, bears NW. and SE.

Leave green timber; enter old burn, bears NW. and SE.

79.50 Spur, slopes S.

80.50 The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7, and 8.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, clay loam and rocky, 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, and cedar.

Undergrowth, vine maple and rhododendron.
