40.00 Set a stone, 12x10x8 ins. in mound of stone, on bedrock for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, from which

A Dogwood, 5 ins. diam., bears S.5*E., 24 lks. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

A Hemlock, 16 ins. diam., bears N.12*W., 37 lks. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

80.00 The cor. to secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12.

Land, rolling.

Soil, 1st rate.

Timber, Fir and Pine.

Undergrowth, Vine Maple.

Heavily timbered.

80.00 chs.

Sept. 22, 1891.

From the Cor. to Secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12.

I run

N.0*1'W., on a random line bet. secs. 1 and 2.

Var.17*45'E.

40.00 Set temporary $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor.

81.25 Intersect North bdy. of Tp. 42 lks. East of the cor. to secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36.

Thence I run

S.0*19'E., on true line bet. secs. 1 and 2.

Var.19*30'E.

Through heavy Fir timber.

19.25 A branch, 5 lks. wide, course East.

36.00 Ascend into Balm brush burn.

41.25 Set a stone, 12x12x8 ins. 8 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on West face, and raised mound of stone, 3x3x2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, along side, pits impracticable no Witness Trees available.

51.00 Descend hill.

60.00 Enter timber (Fir and Pine).
