Set a stone, 12x10x10 ins. 8 ins. in the ground, for cor. to secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35, marked with 1 notch on S and 2 notches on E. edges, from which

A White Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.35°E., 52 lks. marked T 31 S R 2 E S 26 B T.

A White Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.19°E., 13 lks. marked T 31 S R 2 E S 35 B T.

A White Fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.33°W., 41 lks. marked T 31 S R 2 E S 34 B T.

A White Fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.76½°W., 54 lks. marked T 31 S R 2 E S 27 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, 2nd rate.

Timber, Fir and Pine.

Undergrowth, Vine Maple and Lilac.

Heavily timbered and mountainous.

40.00 Set temporary ¼ S cor.

79.60 Intersect the N. and S. line 14 lks. N. of the cor. to 25, 26, 35 and 36.

N.89°45'W., on true line bet. secs. 26 and 35.

Var. 19°26'E.

Ascending gently in heavy timber.

10.80 A creek, 5 lks. wide, course North.

15.40 A creek, 4 lks. wide, course NE.

24.15 A spring, 1 lk. wide, course South.

34.15 A branch, 2 lks. wide, course SE. Ascend.

39.80 A point, about 100 ft. above sec. cor.
