- 6.00 A branch, 3 lks. wide, course NE.
 - 12.00 Enter a swamp.
 - 15.00 Leave swamp, enter heavy timber.
 - 40.00 Set a stone, 10x12x5 ins. 8 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on West face, from which
 - A White Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.58*E., 21 lks. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
 - A Sugar Pine, 72 ins. diam., bears S.85*W., 54 lks. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
 - 44.00 A branch, 2 lks. wide, course East.
 - 79.50 A branch, 5 lks. wide, course East.
 - 80.00 Set a stone, 12x8x6 ins. 8 ins. in the ground, for cor. to secs. 10, 11, 14 and 15 marked with 4 notches on S. and two notches on East edges, from which
 - A White Fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.78*E., 10 lks. marked T 31 S R 2 E S 11 B T.
 - A White Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N.14*W., 14 lks. marked T 31 S R 2 E S 10 B T.
 - An Alder, 6 ins. diam., bears S.34*E., 43 lks. marked T 31 S R 2 E S 14 B T.
 - A White Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.18*W., 60 lks. marked T 31 S R 2 E S 15 B T.
