36.00	Ascending steep hill in heavy timber. Set a stone, 16x12x4 ins. in mound of stone, at ft. of shelly rock bluff marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, from which A Fir, 5 ins. diam., bears S.45*W., 71 lks. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T, raised mound of stone, 3 ft. base and 2 ft. high, along side offset North 160 lks. to avoid bluff.	+ 700
