CHAINS

A hemlock, 15 ins. diam., bears S. $1^{\circ}45'$ W., 44 lks. dist.,
mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 28 BT.

N. $89^{\circ}12'$ W., beginning new measurement.

Descend 217 ft. over broken NW. slope.

6.45 A spring branch, 2 lks. wide, course NE.; ascend slightly over SE.
slope.

9.15 A spring branch, $\frac{1}{2}$ lk. wide, course SE.; ascend 260 ft. over broken
NE. slope.

19.60 Top of spur, slopes N.; descend 65 ft. over NW. slope.

25.10 Bottom of dry ravine, drains NE.; ascend 255 ft. over broken SE.
slope.

32.40 Top of spur, slopes NE.; descend 45 ft. over NW. slope.

34.65 Bottom of dry draw, drains NE.; ascend 118 ft. over NE. slope.

38.20 Top of ridge, bears N. 80° W. and S. 60° E.; descend 15 ft. along
S. slope.

39.56 The cor. of secs. 20, 21, 28 and 29, determined from the remains of
the original bearing trees:

A stump hole bears N. 65° E., 60 lks. dist. (Record: N. 67° E.)

A fir, 72 ins. diam., bears S. 70° E., 75 lks. dist., showing a
charred blaze under 78 years' overgrowth. (Record: S. $51\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E.)

A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears S. $68\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 35 lks. dist., showing a
charred blaze under 78 years' overgrowth. (Record: S. 61° W.)

A fir stump, badly decayed, bears N. 5° W., 22 lks. dist.,
(Record: N. 20° W.)

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground,
with brass cap mkd.

mkd. T 20 S R 6 W S 29 BT.

A hemlock, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 57° W., 26 lks. dist.,
mkd. T 20 S R 6 W S 20 BT.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, clay and sandy clay loam.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, chinquapin, madrona, yew,
and cascara.

Undergrowth, vinemaple, salal, bracken, willow, arrowwood, hazel,
thimbleberry, salmonberry, laurel and poison oak.
