


Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional

	<p>from which</p> <p>A fir, 60 ins. diam., bears N.65°W., 25 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S25 BT.</p> <p>A cedar, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 52°E., 44 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 36 BT.</p> <p>Descend 40 ft. along N. slope.</p>
42.50	A ravine, course NE.; asc. 216 ft. over E. slope.
47.00	A spur, slopes SE.; desc. 111 ft. along broken S. slope.
67.45	A ridge, the divide bet. Clabber Creek and Devils Club Creek, bears N.40°E. and S.20°W.; desc. 240 ft. over W. slope, changing to NW. slope.
69.95	A blazed and graded trail, bears N. 40°E. and S.20°W.
74.40	The head of a ravine, course NW.; desc. 21 ft. along steep N. slope.
77.04	The cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35, and 36.
	<p>Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay and sandy clay loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, chinquapin, madrona, and yew. Undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, slickleaf, manzanita, arrow-wood, and salal.</p>
	<p>N. 0° 35' E., bet. secs. 25 and 26.</p> <p>Descend 120 ft over N. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.</p>
2.55	A ravine, course NW.; asc. 12 ft. along W. slope.
5.35	Top of ascent on W. slope; desc. 185 ft. over NW. slope, changing to N. slope.
13.30	A ravine, course N.65°W.; asc. 64 ft. over SW. slope.
15.80	A small spur, slopes W.; desc. 4 ft. along W. slope.
17.05	A ravine, course SW.; asc. 207 ft. over S. slope, changing to SW. slope.
24.10	Top of ascent on W. slope; desc. 240 ft. along broken W. slope, changing to NW. slope.
35.60	A spur, slopes N.40°W.; desc. 310 ft. over N. slope.
41.96	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 26, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

	<p>from which</p> <p>A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N.21°45'E., 137 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S25 BT.</p> <p>A hemlock, 36 ins. diam., bears N.3°45'W., 29 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S26 BT.</p>
