CHAINS

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked



from which

A fir, 34 ins. diam., bears N.66°E., 29 lks. dist., marked S 35 BT.

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.46°W., 12 lks. dist., marked S 34 BT.

Ascend 220 ft. over broken S. slope.

A blazed and graded trail, and a ridge, at saddle, the divide bet. Marsh Creek and Devils Club Creek, bear N.66°W. and S.66°E.; desc. 100 ft. over N.E. slope.

The head of a ravine, course NE.; asc. 60 ft. over SE. slope.

59.00

A spur, slopes N.20°E.; desc. 350 ft. over broken N. slope.

67.50

A ravine, course N.70°E.; asc. 100ft. over SE. slope.

A spur, slopes N.80°E.; desc. 130 ft. over N.E. slope.

A ravine, course N.60°E.; asc. 70 ft. over SE. slope.

A spur, slopes N.60°E.; desc. 307 ft. over N. slope.

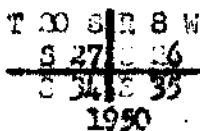

A cedar, 36 ins. diam., bears N.70°E., 37 lks. dist., marked T20 S R S W S 26 BT.

An alder, 24 ins. diam., bears S.31 1/2°E., 116 lks. dist., marked T20 S R S W S 35 BT.

A cedar, 40 ins. diam., bears S.69 1/2°W., 125 lks. dist., marked T20 S R S W S 34 BT.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N.39°45'W., 186 lks. dist., marked T20 S R S W S 27 BT.

Land mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, yew, cascara, chinquapin, madrona, and dogwood.

Undergrowth, vine maple, salmonberry, thimbleberry, devil's-club, hazel, rhododendron, evergreen huckleberry, red huckleberry, and salal.

From the cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35, and 36.
