

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines of T. 20 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS	
	Ascend 11 ft. along N. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
1.30	Top of ascent on N. slope; desc. 265 ft. over NW. slope, changing to W. slope.
8.95	A ravine, course N.10°E.; asc. 265 ft. over E. slope, changing to broken NE. slope.
16.40	The head of a ravine, course N.60°E.; asc. 170 ft. over E. slope.
20.20	A ridge, the divide bet. South Sister Creek and Devils Club Creek, bears N.20°W. and S.20°E.; desc. 305 ft. over SW. slope.
38.42	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 26 and 35, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.  Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins in the ground, with brass cap marked,  <div style="text-align: center;"> <math display="block">\frac{\frac{1}{4} S 26}{S 35}</math>                     1950                 </div> from which  A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N.17 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 50 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S26 BT.  A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S. 83 $\frac{1}{4}$ °E., 44 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S35 BT.  Descend 280 ft. over SW. slope, changing to W. slope.
48.50	A ravine, course SW.; desc. 80 ft. along S. slope, changing to SW. slope.
53.20	A branch, 1 lk. wide, course S.30°W.; asc 13 ft. over SE. slope.
54.10	Top of ascent on S. slope; desc. 145 ft. over SW. slope.
67.85	A ravine, course S.10°E.; asc. 40 ft. over SE. slope.
69.00	Top of ascent on S. slope; desc. 135 ft. over SW. slope.
76.60	Bottom of descent; thence across narrow bottom.
76.84	The cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34, and 35:  Land mountainous. Soil, rocky clay. Timber, fir, cedar, maple, alder, chinquapin, hemlock, madrona, dogwood, yew, and cascara. Undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, salmonberry, thimbleberry, devil's-club, evergreen huckleberry, red huckleberry, Oregon grape, and salal.
	N. 0° 03' E., bet. secs. 26 and 27  Across narrow bottom.
0.20	Ascend 51 ft. over SW. slope, changing to W. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
2.00	Top of ascent on W. slope; desc. 5 ft. over NW. slope.
2.50	A ravine, course S.30°W.; asc. 180 ft. over SW. slope, changing to W. slope.
15.00	Top of ascent on W. slope; desc. 6 ft. over NW. slope.
