

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional  
Lines of T. 20 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

A fir, 46 ins. diam., bears N.23 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 40 lks. dist.,  
marked T20S R8W S22 BT.

The sec. cor. is located on a ridge, the divide bet. Devils Club  
Creek and South Sister Creek, which bears North and S.5°E.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, dogwood, chinquapin, yew,  
and madrona. Undergrowth, vine maple, salmonberry, devil's-club,  
thimbleberry, and salal.

From the cor. of secs. 23, 24, 25, and 26

S. 89° 48' W., bet. secs 23 and 26.

Descend 20 ft. over NW. slope, through heavy timber and dense under-  
growth.

0.40 A branch, 3 lks. wide, course S.55°W.; asc. 60 ft. over SE. slope.

3.30 Top of ascent on S. slope; desc. 150 ft. over SW. slope.

13.00 A branch, 5 lks. wide, course N.20°W.

14.05 The dry bed of a stream, 2 lks. wide, course N.30°E.; asc. 280 ft.  
over NE. slope, changing to broken N. slope.

26.15 The head of a ravine, course NE.; asc. 235 ft. over E. slope.

31.30 A spur ridge, bears N.20°W. and S.20°E.; desc. 270 ft. over SW. slope.

38.93 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 23 and 26, at proportionate dis-  
tance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground,  
with brass cap marked

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.76 $\frac{1}{4}$ °W., 34 lks. dist.,  
marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S23 BT.

A hemlock, 22 ins. diam., bears S.13 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 31 lks. dist.,  
marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S26 BT.

Descend 223 ft. over SW. slope.

45.30 A ravine, course N.35°E.; asc. 505 ft. over E. slope, changing to  
SE. slope.

58.30 A spur ridge, bears N.20°E. and S.20°W.; desc. 200 ft. over W. slope.

62.10 The head of a ravine, course NW.; desc. 164 ft. along N. slope,  
changing to NW. slope.

66.65 A ravine, course N.10°E.; asc. 88 ft. over NE. slope.

69.50 A ravine, course N.80°E.; asc. 381 ft. over SE. slope, changing to  
E. slope.

77.86 The cor. of secs. 22, 23, 26, and 27.

Land extremely mountainous and broken.

and madrona.

Undergrowth, vine maple, salmonberry, thimbleberry, devil's-club,
