	Ascend 22 ft. along ridge, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
1.40	Leave ridge, bears NW. and S.; desc. 210 ft. over NE. slope.
7.85	A ravine, course N. 85° E.; asc. 111 ft. over SE. slope.
11.60	A spur, slopes N. 70° E.; desc. 458 ft over N slope, changing to NE. slope.
22.75	A ravine, course N. 20° W.; asc. 9 ft. along W. slope.
25.70	Top of ascent on W. slope; desc. 136 ft. over NW. slope.
29.50	A branch, 1 lk. wide, course N. 20° E.; asc. 15 ft. over SE. slope.
32.00	Top of ascent on E. slope; desc. 6 ft. over NE. slope.

67.45	A ravine, course N. 80° W.; asc. 48 ft. over SW. slope.
68.90	A spur, slopes W.; desc. 112 ft. over NW. slope.
72.90	South Sister Creek, 30 lks. wide, course S. 40° W.; asc. 31 ft. over gradual SE. slope.
78.80	The cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22, and 23, monumented with the decayed remains of a wooden post, lying in a small mound of stone, located on a blazed line extending N. and S., duly identified.
