

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the
Subdivisional Lines of T. 20 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

A maple, 24 ins. diam., bears N.26°E., 76 lks. dist.,
marked T20S R8W S14 BT.

A fir, 54 ins. diam., bears S.51½° E., 87 lks. dist.,
marked T20S R8W S 23 BT.

A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears S.13°45'W., 161 lks. dist.,
marked T20S R8W S22 BT.

A fir, 50 ins. diam., bears N.79°W., 91 lks. dist.
marked T20S R8W S 15 BT.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, dogwood, chinquapin,
yew, and madrona.

Undergrowth, vine maple, salmonberry, evergreen huckleberry, hazel,
arrowwood, slickleaf, manzanita, poison oak, salal, and devil's-
club.

From the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33, and 34, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.
N. 5° 47' E., bet. secs. 33 and 34.

Ascend 35 ft. over SW. slope, through heavy timber and dense under-
growth.

9.75 A spur ridge, bears N.65°W. and SE.; desc, 585 ft. over broken
N. slope.

23.50 The edge of a marshy bottom, bears N.60°W. and S.60°E.; thence
across bottom.

27.00 Enter meadow, bears E. and W.

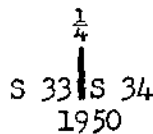
30.75 An abandoned pole and shake barn, bears East, 20 lks. dist.

31.00 Leave meadow, bears E. and W.; asc. 102 ft. over gentle SW. slope.

36.50 Top of ascent on a low ridge, bears N. 60°W. and S.60°E.; desc. 10 ft.
over gradual NE. slope.

41.65 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 33 and 34, at proportionate dist-
ance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground,
with brass cap marked



from which

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S.85°E., 19 lks. dist.,
marked ¼ S34 BT.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N.81°W., 21 lks. dist.,
marked ¼ S33 BT.

Descend 96 ft. over NE. slope.

48.15 A branch, 3 lks. wide, course NW.; asc. 5 ft. across marshy bottom.

49.35 A blazed and graded trail, bears N.60°W. and S.60°E.; desc. 5 ft.
across bottom.

50.80 Marsh Creek, 5 lks. wide, course N.80°W.; asc. 5 ft. across bottom.

53.80 A branch, 2 lks. wide, course S.80°W.; asc. 6 ft. across bottom.
