

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the
Subdivisional Lines of T. 20 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

A cedar, 40 ins. diam., bears N.30°W., 61 lks. dist.,
marked T 20S. R8W S16 BT.

Deposit the remains of the decayed wooden stake at the base of the
iron post.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy, clay loam.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, dogwood, chinquapin, yew,
and madrona.

Undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, arrowwood, evergreen huckleberry,
red huckleberry, devil's-club, salmonberry, and thimbleberry.

From the corner of secs. 14, 15, 22, and 23,

N. 89° 50' W., bet. secs. 15 and 22.

Ascend 187 ft. over SE. slope, through heavy timber and dense under-
growth.

8.45 Top of ascent on S. slope; desc. 135 ft. over SW slope.

13.75 A branch, 2 lks. wide, course S.50°E.; asc. 435 ft. over steep E.
slope, changing to NE. slope.

24.25 A spur, slopes SE.; desc. 330 ft. over SW. slope.

37.85 A branch, 3 lks. wide, course S.30°W.; asc. 34 ft. over SE. slope.

39.20 A small spur, slopes S.; desc. 1 ft. over SW. slope.

39.51 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 15 and 22, at proportionate dis-
tance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground,
with brass cap marked

$$\frac{\frac{1}{4} \text{ S } 15}{\text{S } 22} \\ 1950$$

from which

A hemlock, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 40°E., 37 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S15 BT.

A maple, 16 ins. diam., bears S.17°W., 19 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S22 BT.

Descend 20 ft. over SW. slope.

40.65 A branch, 2 lks. wide, course S.15°E.; 135 ft. over E. slope. asc.

45.60 A spur, slopes S.10°E.; desc. 340 ft. over SW. slope, changing to
W. slope.

68.40 A branch, 5 lks. wide, course SW.; asc. 59 ft. over SE. slope.

71.60 Top of ascent on S. slope; desc. 81 ft. over SW. slope.

77.60 Edge of bottom, bears NW. and SE.; desc. 7 ft. over bottom land.

79.02 The cor. of secs. 15, 16, 21, and 22.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy clay loam.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, chinquapin, madrona, yew,
dogwood and cascara.

Undergrowth, vine maple, salmonberry, evergreen huckleberry, red
huckleberry, rhododendron, devil's-club, thimbleberry, hazel, and
salal.
