72.50	A spur, slopes S.30°E.; desc. 100 ft. over SW. slope.
78.40	A branch, 3 lks. wide, course S.20°E.; asc. 205 ft. over broken E. slope, changing to SE. slope.
86.70	The cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32, and 33. Land, Mountainous, and rolling. Soil, sandy clay loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, chinquapin, madrona, yew, dogwood and cascara. Undergrowth, vine maple, evergreen huckleberry, hazel, salmonberry, thimbleberry, salal, and Oregon grape.
	N. 4° 17' E., bet. secs. 28 and 29. Ascend 80 ft. over SE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
4.50	Top of ascent on E. slope; desc. 110 ft. over NE. slope.
12.50	A ravine, course S.55°E.; asc. 340 ft. over S. slope, changing to SE. slope.
19.30	A spur, slope S.40°E.; desc. 30 ft. over NE. slope.
22.65	A ravine, course S.30°E.; asc. 75 ft. over S. slope.
29.00	A spur, slopes S.70°E.; desc. 35 ft. over NE. slope.
33.00	Bottom of descent on E. slope; asc. 74 ft. over SE. slope.
37.00	A ridge, bears N.5°E. and S.15°W.; desc. 53 ft. along ridge.
