

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional  
Lines of T. 20 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

- 70.05 A branch, 1 lk. wide, course NW.; asc. 69 ft. over SW slope.
- 77.90 A spur, slopes N.70°W.; desc. 57 ft. over NW slope.
- 83.49 A fir, 50 ins. diam., marked with 2 hacks on N. and S. sides.
- 83.78 The cor. of secs. 20, 21, 28, and 29, monumented by a fir, 32 ins. diam., marked with traces of scribe marks in the bark on NE. and SE., S on SW., and S20 on NW. faces, with 4 notches on E. and 2 on S. side, from which the remaining original bearing trees:
- A fir, 34 ins. diam., bears N.60°E., 67 lks. dist., plainly blazed and healed. (Record, 62 lks. dist.)
- A dead fir, 50 ins. diam., bears S.47°W., 36 lks. dist., scribed in the bark BT S29 T20S R8W. (Record bearing, S.50°W., 32 lks. dist.)
- A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.45°W., 46 lks. dist., with illegible scribe marks visible on the bark. I reblaze below the original blaze and mark T20S R8W S20 BT. (Record, 48 lks. dist.)
- And new bearing trees and reference monuments:
- An iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., set 28 ins. in the ground for a reference monument, bears N.89°30'E., 10 lks. dist., with brass cap marked T20S R8W S21 RM 1950 and an arrow pointing to the corner.
- A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.61°E., 56 lks. dist., marked T20S R8W S28 BT.
- A fir, 56 ins. diam., bears S.20½°W., 49 lks. dist., marked T20S R8W S29 BT.
- An iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., set 28 ins. in the ground, for a reference monument, bears S.89°30'W., 10 lks. dist., with brass cap marked T20S R8W S20 RM 1950 and an arrow pointing to the corner.
- Land, mountainous.  
Soil, sandy clay loam.  
Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, yew, madrona, dogwood, and chinquapin.  
Undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, evergreen huckleberry, arrowwood, slickleaf, salal, and salmonberry.
- 
- From the cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27, and 28.
- N. 89° 41' W., bet. secs. 21 and 28.
- Descend 15 ft. along bottom land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
- 8.90 Left bank of Smith River, 120 lks. wide, course S.74¼°W.
- 14.50 Right bank of Smith River; asc. 20 ft. along bottom land.
- 18.00 Top of ascent on bottom land; desc. 5 ft. along bottom.
- 19.30 A branch, 2 lks. wide, course S.15°E.; asc. 13 ft. along bottom.
- 26.80 Approximately 50 lks. South of this point, a graded and blazed trail, bears S.80°W. and S.60°E.
- 34.40 A spring branch, 1 lk. wide, course S.20°E.; asc. 14 ft. along bottom.
