

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the
Subdivisional Lines of T. 20 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS	
6.10	A dirt road, bears N. and S.; end of road is 80 lks. N. of this point. A ridge, bears N. and S.; desc. 421 ft. over broken W. slope.
18.95	A branch, 2 lks. wide, course N.40°W.; asc. 128 ft. over NE. slope.
22.55	A spur, slopes N.; desc. 41 ft. over NW. slope.
24.65	The head of a ravine, course N.; asc. 49 ft. over NE. slope.
27.00	A spur, slopes NW.; desc. 160 ft. over W. slope, changing to SW. slope.
30.40	A ravine, course N.30°W.; desc. 17 ft. along N. slope.
31.80	A ravine, course NE.; asc. 265 ft. over SE. slope.
39.18	The cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32. Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy clay loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, chinquapin, madrona, yew, cascara and dogwood. Undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, evergreen huckleberry, salmonberry, thimbleberry, devil's-club, and salal.
2.90	N. 89° 20' W., bet. secs. 30 and 31. Ascend 114 ft. over SE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth. A spur, slopes N.55°E.; desc. 275 ft. over N. slope, changing to NW. slope.
12.95	A ravine, course N.20°E.; asc. 225 ft. over E. slope, changing to SE. slope.
20.20	The head of a ravine, course S.70°E.; asc. 150 ft. over E. slope.
21.60	A dirt road and a ridge, bear N. and S.; desc. 345 ft. over W. slope.
28.85	A ravine, course N.30°W.; asc. 75 ft. over NE. slope.
31.70	Top of ascent on N. slope; desc. 55 ft. along N. slope, changing to NW. slope.
33.70	A ravine, course N.30°E.; asc. 260 ft. over E. slope, changing to SE. slope.
38.99	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 30 and 31, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

	from which A fir, 38 ins. diam., bears N.53° 45' W., 12 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S30 BT. A fir, 54 ins. diam., bears S. 53° 45' E., 21 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S31 BT.
39.70	Ascend 10 ft. over SE. slope. A spur ridge, bears N.5°E. and S.5°W.; desc. 670 ft. over SW. slope,
