Lines of T. 20 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

changing to W. slope.

60.40 A branch, 3 lks. wide, course N.; asc. 505 ft. over broken NE. slope, changing to SE. slope.

74.60 A spur ridge, bears N. and S.; desc. 491 ft. over broken W. slope.

91.35 The dry bed of a stream, 4 lks. wide, course N. 10° W.; desc. 1 ft. along N. slope.

92.05 The dry bed of a stream, 4 lks. wide, course N. 55° E.; asc. 110 ft. over SE. slope.

96.10 The cor. of secs. 30 and 31, on the W. bdy. of the Tp.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy clay loam.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, chinquapin, dogwood, yew, madrona, and cascara.

Undergrowth, vine maple, evergreen huckleberry, salmonberry, devil's-club, hazel, arrowwood, rhododendron, thimbleberry, red huckleberry, and salal.

From the cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31, and 32.

N. 3° 05' E., bet. secs. 29 and 30.

Ascend 63 ft. over SE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

1.15 A spur, slopes N. 70° E.; desc. 410 ft. over N. slope.

9.35 The dry bed of a stream, 5 lks. side, course NE.; asc. 140 ft. over SE. slope.

14.50 Top of ascent on E. slope; desc. 140 ft. along steep E. slope, changing to broken NE. slope.

21.00 A spur, slopes NE.; desc. 45 ft. over N. slope.

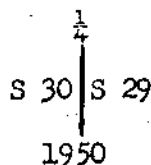
23.00 A branch, 3 lks. wide, course E.; asc. 250 ft. over SE. slope.

33.20 A spur, slopes E.; desc. 63 ft. over NE. slope.

34.90 A ravine, course SE.; asc. 200 ft. over S. slope.

40.19 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 29 and 30, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked,



from which

A hemlock, 10 ins. diam., bears East, 13 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S29 BT.

A fir, 60 ins. diam., bears S. 78° W., 25 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S30 BT.

The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. is located on a spur, which slopes S. 55° E.

Descend 125 ft. over NE. slope.
