CHAINS

- 4.50 The head of a ravine, course N.70°W.; desc. 320 ft. along N. slope, changing to W. slope.
- 13.65 The dry bed of a stream, 5 lks. wide, course N.; asc. 485 ft. over E. slope, changing to NE. slope.
- 24.90 A spur, slopes S.60°E.; asc. 75 ft. along S. slope, changing to SE. slope.
- 30.15 A ridge, bears N.10°E. and S.10°W. desc. 190 ft. over W. slope.
- 34.60 A ravine, course SW.; desc. 45 ft. over broken SW. slope.
- 36.80 A ravine, course S.; asc. 70 ft. over SE. slope.
- 39.60 A spur, slopes S.30°W.; desc. 4 ft. over W. slope.
- 40.16 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 20 and 29, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
- Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

- A fir, 60 ins. diam., bears N.20°E., 5 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S20 BT.
- A hemlock, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 31°45' W., 58 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S29 BT.
- Descend 155 ft. over W. slope.
- 43.60 A ravine, course S.30°W.; asc. 100 ft. over SE. slope.
- 47.65 A spur, slopes S.80°W.; desc. 150 ft. over W. slope, changing to S. slope.
- 54.10 A spur, slopes S.30° W.; desc. 165 ft. over W. slope.
- 58.40 A branch, 3 lks. wide, course SW.; desc. 85 ft. over broken SW. slope.
- 60.50 A creek, 10 lks. wide, course N.20°W.; asc. 120 ft. over NE. slope, changing to N. slope.
- 65.10 A ravine, course N.60°E.; asc. 280 ft. over SE. slope.
- 71.55 A spur, slopes N.50°E.; desc. 65 ft. over NW. slope.
- 73.90 The head of a ravine, course NE.; asc. 100 ft. over NE. slope, changing to E. slope.
- 76.45 A spur ridge, bears SE. and W.; desc. 24 ft. along spur ridge.
- 78.30 Leave spur ridge, bears N. 70° W. and E.; asc. 5 ft. along S. slope.
- 80.32 The cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29, and 30.
- Land mountainous. Soil, sandy clay loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, chinquapin, madrona, yew, dogwood and cascara. Undergrowth, vine maple, evergreen huckleberry, salmonberry, salal, slickleaf, thimbleberry, devil's-club and hazel.
