

Dependent Resurvey of Part of the South Boundary of
T. 21 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

A fir, 52 ins. diam., bears S. $16\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 75 lks. dist.,
mkd. on bark T 22 S R 8 W S 4 B T. I re-blaze and re-mark
this old bearing tree T 22 S R 8 W S 4 C C B T.

The old SW. bearing tree has fallen and slidden down the mount-
ain.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S. $53\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 52 lks. dist.,
mkd. T 22 S R 8 W S 5 C C B T. (New B.T.)

Desc. 158 ft. over SE. slope.

31.60 A branch, 2 lks. wide, course SE.; asc. 17 ft. over SW. slope.

32.70 A spur, slopes S.; desc. 10 ft. over SE. slope.

33.85 A ravine, course SW.; asc. 25 ft. over SW. slope.

37.40 A spur, slopes S.; desc. 29 ft. over SE. slope.

39.50 The corner of sections 32 and 33 the locus of which is determined
at the record bearing and distance from the old NE. bearing tree.

At point for corner,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground,
for cor. of secs. 32 and 33, with brass cap mkd.

An alder, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 52° E., 42 lks. dist.,
with no marks remaining on decayed face of old blaze. (Old B.T.)

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N. $45\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 53 lks. dist.,
mkd. T 21 S R 8 W S 33 B T. (New B.T.)

A cedar, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 70° W., 53 lks. dist.,
mkd. T 21 S R 8 W S 32 B T.

This sec. cor. is located in head of ravine, course S., at upper
edge of an old landslide.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, loose sandy loam, 1st and 2nd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, yew, dogwood, chinquapin,
madrona and cascara.

Undergrowth, rhododendron, huckleberry, slickleaf, hazel, salal,
manzanita, bracken, salmonberry, raspberry, thimbleberry, vine-
maple and poison oak.

N. $89^{\circ} 33'$ E., on S. bdy. of sec. 33.

Asc. 52 ft. over SW. slope, through heavy timber and dense under-
growth.

6.50 Spur, slopes S.; desc. 54 ft. over SE. slope.

13.95 Head of ravine, course S.; asc. 53 ft. over SW. slope.

17.30 A spur, slopes S. 20° W.; desc. 19 ft. over SE. slope.

18.90 A branch, 1 lk. wide, course SW.; asc. 245 ft. over SW. slope.
