

Dependent Resurvey of the W. Bdy. of T. 21 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

Land, mountainous.  
Soil, loose sandy loam, 1st and 2nd rate.  
Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, and maple.  
Undergrowth, slickleaf, rhododendron, vinemaple, salal, manzanita, salmonberry, willow, hazel, arrowwood, bracken, thimbleberry, raspberry and poison oak.

N. 1° 03' E., on W. bdy. of sec. 30.

Asc. 9 ft. over SW. slope, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth, in logged and burned area.

1.00 A small spur, slopes SW.; desc. 14 ft. over NW. slope.

5.00 Head of ravine, course SW.; asc. 154 ft. over broken SW. slope.

37.64 The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 30 only, a sawed fir stump, 38 ins. diam., 7 ft. high, mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S on N. side; from which

A maple stool, bears N. 45° E., 13 lks. dist., remains of old bearing tree.

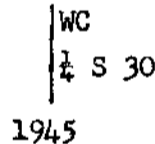
A dogwood stool, bears S. 60° W., 20 lks. dist., remains of old bearing tree.

Thence

N. 0° 29' E., with new measurement.

Over gentle W. slope.

0.10 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for witness cor. to the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 30 only, with brass cap mkd.



from which

A fir, 28 ins. diam., bears N. 40° E., 183 lks. dist., mkd. W C  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 30 B T.

A fir, 28 ins. diam., bears N. 80 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° E., 245 lks. dist., mkd. W C  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 30 B T.

Asc. 165 ft. over broken SW. slope.

22.60 A spur, slopes W.; desc. 7 ft. over NW. slope.

24.90 A shallow ravine, course SW.; asc. 80 ft. over SE. slope.

27.00 A spur, slopes E.; desc. 3 ft. over NE. slope.

27.75 Same ravine, course SE.; asc. 353 ft. over broken S. slope, changing to broken W. slope.

38.61 The closing cor. of secs. 24 and 25, the locus of which is determined by reference to the record bearing and distance from the old NE. bearing tree and record distance from the old NW. bearing tree.

At point for corner,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of secs. 24 and 25, with brass cap mkd.
