

Dependent Resurvey of the W. Bdy. of T. 21 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

- 9.00 A ridge, divide between waters tributary to Smith River and Umpqua River, bears N. 70° E. and S. 70° W.; desc. 373 ft. over NW. slope.
- 10.67 A logging road, bears N. 80° E. and S. 80° W.
- 19.15 A branch, 4 lks. wide, course NE.; asc. 117 ft. over SE. slope.
- 24.80 A spur, slopes E.; desc. 33 ft. over NE. slope.
- 26.80 A damp ravine, course NE.; asc. 87 ft. over SE. slope.
- 32.00 A spur, slopes NE.; desc. 274 ft. over NW. slope, changing to NE. slope.
- 39.15 Proportional measurement.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 19 only, with brass cap mkd.

A hemlock, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 52° E., 87 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 19 B T.

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 41 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 19 B T.

Desc. 139 ft. over NE. slope.

- 41.75 Big Creek, 10 lks. wide, course E.; asc. 590 ft. over S. slope, changing to SW. slope, gradually entering a stand of green timber, in burn.
- 44.30 Big Creek road, bears N. 72° W. and S. 85° E.
- 66.90 A spur, slopes W.; desc. 8 ft. over NW. slope.
- 69.60 Head of ravine, course W.; asc. 129 ft. over SW. slope.
- 73.40 A ridge, bears NW. and SE.; thence over broken E. slope in heavily burned area.
- 75.38 The closing cor. of secs. 13 and 24, the locus of which is determined by reference to the record distance from the old SE. bearing tree, record bearing from the old SW. bearing tree, and record bearing and distance from the old NW. bearing tree.

At point for corner,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of secs. 13 and 24, with brass cap mkd.

A dead hemlock, 42 ins. diam., bears S. 24° E., 21 lks. dist., with blaze healed. (Old B.T.)

A dead hemlock, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 36° W., 52 lks. dist., with partial scribe marks visible on partially healed old blaze. (Old B.T.)
