CHAINS

A dead hemlock, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 47° E., 33 lks. dist., with partial scribe marks remaining on charred face of old blaze. (Old B.T.)

No other accessories available.

Desc. 111 ft. over NE. slope.

78.30 The cor. of secs. 18 and 19, the locus of which is determined at the record bearing and distance from the old NE. and SW. bearing trees.

At point for corner,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 18 and 19, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N. 45½° E., 151 lks. dist., mkd. T 21 S R 8 W S 18 B T. (New B.T.)

A dead fir, 60 ins. diam., bears S. 66½° E., 62 lks. dist., mkd. T 21 S R 8 W S 19 B T. (New B.T.)

Land, mountainous.

Soil, loose sandy and rocky loam, 1st, 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, chinquapin and madrona.

Undergrowth, rhododendron, vinemaple, salmonberry, salal, willow, bracken, arrowwood, slickleaf, manzanita, hazel, thimbleberry, raspberry, blackberry and poison oak.
