28.30

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 18 only, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 50 ins. diam., bears N. $85\frac{1}{2}^\circ$ E., 217 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 18 B T.

A fir, 34 ins. diam., bears S. $39\frac{1}{2}^\circ$ E., 143 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 18 B T.

Asc. 630 ft. over SW. slope.

67.10 A spur ridge, bears E. and W.; desc. 145 ft. over NW. slope.

75.63 The closing cor. of secs. 12 and 13, the badly decayed remains of a wooden stake which shows evidence of axe and scribe marks, lying loose on the ground, near which I unearth the sharpened portion of same.

At point for corner,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with remains of marked stake deposited at the base, for closing cor. of secs. 12 and 13, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 34° W., 251 lks. dist., mkd. T 21 S R 9 W S 12 C C B T. (New B.T.)

76.60 The cor. of secs. 7 and 18, a badly decayed hemlock stump, 20 ins. diam., with evidence of old axe marks only.

At point for corner,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 7 and 18. with brass cap mkd.

A dead hemlock, 22 ins. diam., bears N. $69\frac{1}{2}^\circ$ E., 47 lks. dist., with traces of scribe marks on face of old blaze. (Old B.T.)

A dead hemlock, 30 ins. diam., bears S. 43° E., 44 lks. dist., with traces of scribe marks on face of old blaze. (Old B.T.)

A dead hemlock, 26 ins. diam., bears S. 58° W., 52 lks. dist., with old blaze burned. (Old B.T.)

A dead cedar, 14 ins. diam., bears S. $62\frac{1}{2}^\circ$ W., 16 lks. dist., with old blaze burned. (Old B.T.)
