Dependent Resurvey of the W. Bdy. of T. 21 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N.  $18\frac{1}{2}^\circ$  E., 45 lks. dist.,  
mkd. T 21 S R 8 W S 7 B T. (New B.T.)

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.  $57\frac{1}{2}^\circ$  E., 155 lks. dist.,  
mkd. T 21 S R 8 W S 18 B T. (New B.T.)

This sec. cor. is located at foot of descent on W. slope.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, loose sandy loam, 1st and 2nd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder and maple.

Undergrowth, salmonberry, vinemaple, rhododendron, willow, bracken,  
hazel, arrowwood, slickleaf, manzanita, salal, raspberry and  
poison oak.

N.  $0^\circ 20'$  E., on W. bdy. of sec. 7.

Asc. 24 ft. over SW. slope, through heavy dead timber and scatter-  
ing green timber and dense undergrowth, in burn.

6.10 A spur, slopes W.; desc. 624 ft. over NW. slope.

24.10 A branch, 4 lks. wide, course NE.; asc. 340 ft. over SE. slope.

38.28 Proportional measurement.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground,  
for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 7 only, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 37 ins. diam., bears S.  $57\frac{1}{4}^\circ$  E., 165 lks. dist.,  
mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 7 B T.

Asc. 6 ft. over SE. slope.

38.75 A spur, slopes E.; desc. 323 ft. over NE. slope.

46.40 A branch, 2 lks. wide, course SE.; asc. 678 ft. over broken SW.  
slope.

67.30 A spur, slopes S.  $80^\circ$  E.; enter heavy green timber, bears E. and W.,  
in burn. Desc. 388 ft. over broken N. slope.

75.20 The closing cor. of secs. 1 and 12, the badly decayed remains of a  
wooden post, on which only traces of axe marks and scribe marks  
were found.

At point for corner,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground,  
for closing cor. of secs. 1 and 12, with brass cap mkd.
