

Dependent Resurvey of the W. Bdy. of T. 21 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

marks C C T 21 S R 9 W S 1 & S 12 B T.

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S.  $64\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W., 37 lks. dist., an old bearing tree with the scribe marks B T uncovered.

A fir stub, 9 ins. diam., bears N.  $62^{\circ} 45'$  W., 27 lks. dist., mkd. T 21 S R 9 W S 1 B T. (Old B.T.)

A fir, 34 ins. diam., bears N.  $39^{\circ} 45'$  W., 67 lks. dist., mkd. T 21 S R 9 W S 1 C C B T. (New B.T.)

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.  $70\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W., 46 lks. dist., mkd. T 21 S R 9 W S 12 C C B T. (New B.T.)

Desc. 35 ft. over NE. slope.

76.56 The cor. of secs. 6 and 7, the decayed and partially burned remains of a wooden stake on which axe marks and partial scribe marks were found.

At point for corner,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 6 and 7, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 26 ins. diam., bears N.  $42\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E., 36 lks. dist., mkd. T 21 S R 8 W S 6 B T. (New B.T.)

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.  $4\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E., 51 lks. dist., mkd. T 21 S R 8 W S 7 B T. (New B.T.)

Land, mountainous.

Soil, loose sandy loam, 1st and 2nd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, chinquapin, madrona, yew, and dogwood.

Undergrowth, vinemaple, rhododendron, salmonberry, salal, willow, slickleaf, arrowwood, manzanita, hazel, bracken, raspberry and poison oak.

N.  $1^{\circ} 10'$  W., on W. bdy. of sec. 6.

Desc. 108 ft. over NE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth, in burn.

2.95 A branch, 1 lk. wide, course E.; asc. 144 ft. over SE. slope.

8.50 A spur, slopes E.; desc. 212 ft. over NE. slope.

12.40 A branch, 1 lk. wide, course E.; asc. 71 ft. over SE. slope.

14.30 A spur, slopes E.; desc. 16 ft. over NE. slope.

16.00 A ravine, course SE.; asc. 290 ft. over S. slope.

21.30 A spur, slopes SE.; desc. 183 ft. over NE. slope.

27.00 A branch, 1 lk. wide, course E.; asc. 22 ft. over SE. slope.
