- 9.50 A ravine, course N.; asc. 95 ft. over NW. slope.
- 11.70 A spur, slopes N.; desc. 61 ft. over NE. slope.
- 14.20 A ravine, course NW.; asc. 42 ft. over SW. slope.
- 15.30 Top of ascent on N. slope; desc. 18 ft. along broken N. slope.
- 20.90 A spur, slopes NE.; desc. 129 ft. over E. slope.
- 23.60 A branch, 2 lks. wide, course N. 5° W.; asc. 108 ft. over SW. slope.

- A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 36½° E., 128 lks. dist., mkd. T 21 S R 8 W S 5 B T. (New B.T.)
- A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S. 10° W., 176 lks. dist., mkd. T 21 S R 8 W S 6 B T. (New B.T.)
- A maple, 14 ins. diam., bears N. 83° W., 55 lks. dist., mkd. T 20 S R 8 W S 31 B T. (New B.T.)
