

Dependent Resurvey of Part of the North Boundary of  
T. 21 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears S.  $43\frac{1}{2}^\circ$  W., 100 lks. dist.,  
mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 4 B T. (New B.T.)

Thence

S.  $89^\circ 15'$  E., with new measurement.

Asc. 224 ft. over broken W. slope, through heavy timber and dense  
undergrowth, in area subjected to a light ground fire.

- 0.50 Smith River Trail, bears N. and S.
- 15.90 A spur, slopes SW.; desc. 76 ft. over SE. slope.
- 19.90 A ravine, course S.; asc. 120 ft. over SW. slope.
- 24.40 A spur, slopes NW.; desc. 87 ft. over NE. slope.
- 28.10 A branch, 3 lks. wide, course NW.; asc. 292 ft. over broken W. slope.
- 39.14 The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, the locus of which is determined  
by reference to the record distances from the old NE., SE., and  
SW. bearing trees.

At point for corner,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground,  
for cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, with brass cap mkd.

- A fir, 28 ins. diam., bears S.  $44^\circ 45'$  E., 36 lks. dist.,  
with blaze healed. (Old B.T.)
- A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.  $24\frac{1}{2}^\circ$  W., 25 lks. dist.,  
with blaze healed. (Old B.T.)
- A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S.  $70^\circ$  W., 43 lks. dist.,  
mkd. T 21 S R 8 W S 4 B T. (New B.T.)
- A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N.  $61^\circ$  W., 60 lks. dist.,  
mkd. T 20 S R 8 W S 33 B T. (New B.T.)

Land, mountainous.

Soil, loose sandy and rocky loam, 1st, 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, yew, dogwood, madrona,  
chinquapin, cherry, and cascara.

Undergrowth, vinemaple, huckleberry, salmonberry, salal, manzanita,  
slickleaf, willow, bracken, hazel, arrowwood, rhododendron, rasp-  
berry, thimbleberry, blackberry, poison oak and Devil's club.
