CHAINS

Asc. 190 ft. over SE. slope, through heavy dead timber.

5.10 Devil's Grave, bears N. 79° W., 27.30 chs. dist.

5.20 A ridge, divide between Smith River and Umpqua River, bears N. 75° E. and W.; a poor foot trail on top of ridge; desc. 437 ft. over broken N. slope.

13.70 A ravine, course NW.; asc. 80 ft. over SW. slope.

16.90 A spur, slopes W.; desc. 16 ft. over NW. slope.

18.50 A ravine, course W.; asc. 142 ft. over SW. slope.

22.80 A spur, slopes W.; desc. 18 ft. over broken W. slope.

29.88 The cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27 and 28, determined at the record bearings and distances from all of the old bearing trees.

At point for corner,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27 and 28, with brass cap mkd.

A dead fir, 32 ins. diam., bears N. 37° E., 26 lks. dist., with blaze healed. (Old B.T.)

A hemlock stub, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 45° E., 39 lks. dist., with blaze healed. (Old B.T.)

A dead fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 27° W., 18 lks. dist., with blaze healed. (Old B.T.)

A dead fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N. 10° W., 26 lks. dist., on which I uncover the scribe marks B T T 21 S R 8 W S 21. (Old B.T.)

A dead fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S. 13° 45' W., 135 lks. dist., mkd. T 21 S R 8 W S 28 B T. (New B.T.)

Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, loose sandy and rocky loam, 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, madrona, live oak, chinquapin, dogwood and cascara.

Undergrowth, rhododendron, vinemaple, huckleberry, salal, salmonberry, slickleaf, manzanita, willow, lilac, hazel, arrowwood, raspberry, and poison oak.

N. 1° 05' E., bet. secs. 21 and 22.

Desc. 14 ft. over broken NW. slope, through heavy dead timber and dense undergrowth.

2.85 A spur, slopes N. 30° W.; desc. 567 ft. over broken N. slope.

14.30 Dry bed of creek, 5 lks. wide, course N. 70° W.; asc. 203 ft. over SW. slope.

24.70 A spur, slopes W.; desc. 95 ft. over NW. slope.

27.10 A ravine, course W.; asc. 6 ft. over SW. slope.
