CHAINS

43.40 Top of ascent on W. slope; desc. 89 ft. over rolling NW. slope.

62.13 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., the locus of which is determined by reference to the record bearing and distance from each of the old bearing trees.

At point for corner,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

An uprooted fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 54° E., 23 lks. dist., with blaze healed. (Old B.T.)

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 85° W., 45 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. (Old B.T.)

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S. 20° E., 59 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 10 B T. (New B.T.)

A fir, 38 ins. diam., bears N. 89° W., 67 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 9 B T. (New B.T.)

Thence

N. 0° 21' E., with new measurement.

Desc. 25 ft. over rolling NW. slope.

4.30 Smith River, 95 lks. wide, course N. 60° E.; banks 4 to 10 ft. high; water is low at present stage and from 2 to 5 ft. deep; asc. 275 ft. over SE. slope.

12.98 The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10, the almost disintegrated remains of a wooden stake on which no marks remain.

At point for corner,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with the decayed remains of wooden stake deposited at the base, for cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N. 39° E., 22 lks. dist., with blaze healed. (Old B.T.)

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 63 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 34 lks. dist., with partial scribe marks visible on old blaze which has been opened up. (Old B.T.)

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 70° W., 39 lks. dist., with blaze healed. I re-blaze and re-mark this old bearing tree T 21 S R 8 W S 9 B T.

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N. 80° W., 16 lks. dist., with blaze healed. I re-blaze and re-mark this old bearing tree T 21 S R 8 W S 4 B T.

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S. 69° E., 40 lks. dist., mkd. T 21 S R 8 W S 10 B T. (New B.T.)
