

Dependent Resurvey of Part of the Subdivision of  
T. 21 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

The sec. cor. is located on top of a spur ridge, bears E. and SW.

Land, rolling and mountainous.  
Soil, loose sandy loam, 1st and 2nd rate.  
Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, madrona, yew, chinquapin, dogwood, cherry and cascara.  
Undergrowth, vinemaple, salmonberry, rhododendron, salal, huckleberry, willow, thimbleberry, bracken, arrowwood, hazel, manzanita, and poison oak.

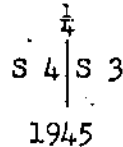
From the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., heretofore described.

S. 1° 37' E., bet. secs. 3 and 4.

Desc. 35 ft. over W. slope, changing to SW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

- 5.50 A ravine, course SW.; asc. 12 ft. over NW. slope.
- 6.40 A spur, slopes W.; desc. 27 ft. over SW. slope.
- 8.95 A damp ravine, course NW.; asc. 82 ft. over NE. slope.
- 13.30 A spur, slopes NW.; desc. 468 ft. over broken SW. slope.
- 30.90 A branch, 3 lks. wide, course SW.; asc. 445 ft. over NW. slope.
- 40.20 A spur, slopes W.; desc. 13 ft. over SW. slope.
- 41.00 Proportional measurement.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S. 64 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 48 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 3 B T.

A fir, 22 ins. diam., bears N. 47 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 36 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 4 B T.

Desc. 439 ft. over SW. slope, changing to SE. slope.

- 57.15 A branch, 1 lk. wide, course SW.; asc. 16 ft. over NW. slope.
- 58.30 A spur, slopes W.; desc. 110 ft. over SW. slope.
- 71.66 A graded and graveled road, bears N. 39° W. and S. 45° E.
- 74.90 Smith River, 140 lks. wide, course N. 40° W.; banks 3 to 9 ft. high; water is low at present stage and from 1 $\frac{1}{2}$  to 4 ft. deep; asc. 306 ft. over NE. slope.
- 82.68 The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10.
