Dependent Resurvey of Part of the Subdivision of
T. 21 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

From the cor. of secs. 32 and 33, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., heretofore described,

N. 0° 54' E., bet. secs. 32 and 33.

Asc. 458 ft. over S. slope, changing to SE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

17.80 A ridge, divide bet. Weatherly Creek and Umpqua River, and a foot trail, bears N. 85° E. and S. 80° W.; enter heavy dead timber and scattering green timber, in burn, bears N. 85° E. and S. 80° W.; desc. 453 ft. over broken NW. slope.

28.30 A ravine, course NW.; asc. 17 ft. over SW. slope.

31.00 A spur, slopes NW.; desc. 117 ft. over NW. slope.

36.60 A ravine, course W.; asc. 35 ft. over SW. slope.

37.82 Proportional measurement.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 204 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 33 B T.

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 171 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 32 B T.

Asc. 105 ft. over SW. slope.

41.20 A spur, slopes W.; desc. 19 ft. over NW. slope.

43.90 A ravine, course W.; asc. 128 ft. over SW. slope.

47.40 A spur, slopes NW.; desc. 396 ft. over NE. slope.

55.40 A ravine, course NW.; asc. 72 ft. over SW. slope.

59.80 A spur, slopes N. 60° W.; desc. 187 ft. over NW. slope.

67.00 Weatherly Creek, 15 lks. wide, course S. 70° W.; asc. 242 ft. over SE. slope.

75.64 The proportionate point for cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33 falls on steep insecure ground with bedrock about 4 ins. below surface.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, loose sandy and rocky loam, 1st, 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, madrona, yew, chinquapin, oak, dogwood, cherry and cascara.

Undergrowth, vinemaple, salmonberry, huckleberry, salal, hazel, manzanita, slickleaf, arrowwood, lilac, bracken, willow, raspberry, thimbleberry and poison oak.

From the cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34

S. 87° 26' W., bet. secs. 28 and 33.

Desc. 7 ft. over broken N. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth, in burn.
