CHAINS

- 2.60 Ravine, course N. 65° E.; asc. 553 ft. over SE. slope, changing to NE. slope.
- 14.80 A spur ridge, bears NW. and SE.; Cedar Creek Trail, bears NW. and SE.; desc. 245 ft. over SW. slope.
- 23.80 Cedar Creek, 1 lk. wide, course SE.; asc. 284 ft. over broken E. slope.
- 30.70 A ridge, divide bet. Weatherly Creek and Cedar Creek, bears N. 20° E. and S. 20° W.; trail, bears N. 20° E. and S. 20° W.; desc. 270 ft. over NW. slope, changing to precipitous W. slope.

- 47.60 A ravine, course N. 15° W.; asc. 36 ft. over NE. slope.
- 48.60 A spur, slopes N. 25° W.; desc. 45 ft. over NW. slope.
- 51.50 A ravine, course N. 30° W.; desc. 40 ft. over broken NW. slope.
- 57.20 A spur, slopes NW.; desc. 111 ft. over NW. slope, changing to SW. slope.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, loose sandy and rocky loam, 1st, 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, madrona, chinquapin, dogwood, oak and cascara.

Undergrowth, vinemaple, rhododendron, hucklebery, salal, salmonberry, manzanita, slickleaf, willow, hazel, bracken, thimbleberry, raspberry, lilac, poison oak, arrowwood, and Devil's club.

From the true point for the cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33

N. 0° 35' E., bet. secs. 28 and 29.

Asc. 143 ft. over SE. slope, through heavy dead timber and scattering green timber and dense undergrowth, in burn.
