CHAINS

A dead cedar, 30 ins. diam., bears S. 76° W., 72 lks. dist.,
mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 28 B T.

Asc. 219 ft. over NE. slope.

43.50 A ridge, divide between Smith River and Umpqua River, and foot trail,
bears NW. and SE.; desc. 190 ft. over SW. slope.

51.00 Head of ravine, course S.; asc. 275 ft. over broken S. slope, chang-
ing to NE. slope.

70.25 Top of same ridge, bears N. 15° E. and N. 88° W.; foot trail, bears
N. 15° E. and W.; desc. 89 ft. along top of ridge.

75.00 Foot trail, bears E. and N. 87 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W.

78.29 The cor. of secs. 20, 21, 28 and 29.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, loose sandy and rocky loam, 1st, 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, chinquapin, madrona,
cherry, yew and dogwood.

Undergrowth, vinemaple, rhododendron, salmonberry, salal, willow,
hazel, huckleberry, raspberry, thimbleberry, bracken, slickleaf,
manzanita, arrowwood and poison oak.

N. 0° 50' E., bet. secs. 20 and 21.

Desc. 469 ft. over N. slope, changing to NW. slope, through heavy
dead timber and scattering green timber and dense undergrowth, in
burn.

0.06 Foot trail, bears E. and W.

13.20 A ravine, course NW.; desc. 162 ft. over broken NW. slope.

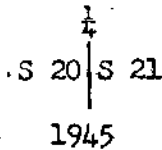
22.00 Dry bed of creek, 5 lks. wide, course N. 20° E.; asc. 125 ft. over
SE. slope.

32.50 Spur, slopes N. 25° E.; asc. 130 ft. over NW. slope.

34.70 A branch, 1 lk. wide, course NE.; asc. 46 ft. over SE. slope.

37.82 Proportional measurement.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground,
for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

42.80 A spur, slopes NE.; desc. 284 ft. over NE. slope.

50.20 West Fork of Mosetown Creek, water in pools, 5 lks. wide, course
NW.; asc. 190 ft. over SW. slope.

64.20 A spur, slopes W.; desc. 275 ft. over NW. slope.
