CHAINS

72.80 Enter marshy lake, water about 2 ft. deep with soft mud bottom, bears NE. and SW.

75.20 Leave lake, bears NE. and SW.; asc. 4 ft. over SE. slope.

75.64 Proportional measurement.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 16, 17, 20 and 21, with brass cap mkd.

A maple, 24 ins. diam., bears S. 69½° W., 72 lks. dist., mkd. T 21 S R 8 W S 20 B T.

A dead fir, 50 ins. diam., bears N. 9¼° W., 105 lks. dist., mkd. T 21 S R 8 W S 17 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, loose sandy and rocky loam, 1st, 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, chinquapin, cherry and madrona.

Undergrowth, vinemaple, rhododendron, salmonberry, salal, huckleberry, manzanita, slickleaf, thimble berry, bracken, raspberry, blackberry, hazel and poison oak.

N. 89° 58' W., bet. secs. 16 and 21.

Asc. 26 ft. over SE. slope, through heavy dead timber and scattering green timber and dense undergrowth, in burn.

3.20 A spur, slopes S.; desc. 41 ft. over SW. slope.

6.55 A branch, 2 lks. wide, course S. 75° E.; asc. 744 ft. over broken NE. slope.

34.85 Spur ridge, bears N. and S.; desc. 143 ft. over NW. slope, changing to W. slope.

39.33 Proportional measurement.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
