Dependent Resurvey of Part of the Subdivision of
T. 21 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

- 3.85 Mosetown Trail, bears N. and S.
- 14.80 A spur, slopes N.; desc. 424 ft. over broken NW. slope.
- 37.40 A spring branch, 1 lk. wide, course NW.
- 39.80 Blind Creek, 12 lks. wide, course N.; asc. 25 ft. over E. slope.
- 40.30 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., the locus of which is determined at the record bearing and distance from each of the old bearing trees.
- At point for corner,
- Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
- $$\begin{array}{r} \frac{1}{4} \text{ S } 4 \\ \hline \text{S } 9 \\ 1945 \end{array}$$
- from which
- A fallen cedar, 50 ins. diam., bears North, 28 lks. dist., with blaze healed. (Old B.T.)
- A fir, 32 ins. diam., bears S. 10° W., 19 lks. dist., an old bearing tree, with blaze healed. I re-blazed and re-marked this tree $\frac{1}{4}$ S 9 B T.
- A fir, 22 ins. diam., bears N. 41° W., 76 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 4 B T. (New B.T.)
- Thence
- S. 89° 29' W., with new measurement.
- Asc. 601 ft. over broken E. slope.
- 27.00 A spur ridge, bears N. 20° E. and S. 40° W.; enter burned area, bears NE. and SW.; desc. 230 ft. over broken W. slope.
- 33.00 A ravine, course NW.; asc. 54 ft. over NE. slope.
- 36.00 A spur, slopes N. 20° W.; desc. 103 ft. over NW. slope.
- 39.00 A bare bedrock ravine with trickle of water, course N.; asc. 62 ft. over NE. slope.
- 39.84 The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9.
- Land, mountainous.
Soil, sandy and rocky loam, 1st, 2nd and 3rd rate.
Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, chinquapin, madrona, yew, dogwood, cherry and cascara.
Undergrowth, vinemaple, rhododendron, salal, salmonberry, willow, bracken, hazel, manzanita, slickleaf, poison oak, arrowwood and thimbleberry.
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- From the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., heretofore described
- S. 1° 20' E., bet. secs. 4 and 5.
- Asc. 134 ft. over NE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth, in burn.
- 2.50 A spur, slopes S. 60° E.; desc. 263 ft. over broken S. slope.
- 8.80 A branch, 1 lk. wide, course SE.; asc. 50 ft. over NE. slope.
