- 11.30 A spur, slopes W.; desc. 29 ft. over NW. slope.  
12.50 Weatherly Creek, 20 lks. wide, course S. 75° W.; asc. 833 ft. over broken SE. slope, changing to SW. slope.  
21.00 A branch, 1 lk. wide, course SE.  
25.30 A branch, 1 lk. wide, course SE.  
33.00 A branch, 1 lk. wide, course SE.  
36.935 Proportional measurement.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 65 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° E., 312 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 32 B T.

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S. 35 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° W., 85 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 31 B T.

Asc. 371 ft. over broken SW. slope.

- 73.60 A spur, slopes SW.; thence over rolling broken W. slope.  
73.87 The cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32, a fir, 32 ins. diam., with partial scribe marks on NE., SE., SW., and NW. side, on bark; from which

A fir, 38 ins. diam., bears N. 40° E., 48 lks. dist., with partial scribe marks on bark. (Old B.T.)

A burnt fir stump, 36 ins. diam., bears S. 65° E., 21 lks. dist., on which no marks remain. (Old B.T.)

A burnt fir stump, 36 ins. diam., bears S. 23° W., 30 lks. dist., on which no marks remain. (Old B.T.)

A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N. 62 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 54 lks. dist., with partial scribe marks on bark. (Old B.T.)

Land, mountainous.

Soil, loose, sandy, rocky loam, 1st, 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, chinquapin, madrona, dogwood, cherry and cascara.

Undergrowth, vinemaple, rhododendron, salal, salmonberry, manzanita, slickleaf, bracken, hazel and poison oak.

From the true point for the cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33

S. 88° 00' W., bet. secs. 29 and 32.

Asc. 49 ft. over SE. slope, through heavy dead timber and scattering green timber and dense undergrowth, in burn.

- 2.20 A spur, slopes S.; desc. 143 ft. over SW. slope.  
10.10 A branch, 1 lk. wide, course S.; asc. 531 ft. over SE. slope, changing to NE. slope.  
27.00 A spur, slopes SE.; desc. 79 ft. over SW. slope, over bare bed-rock.
