Dependent Resurvey of Part of the Subdivision of  
T. 21 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

Land, mountainous.  
Soil, loose sandy and rocky loam, 1st, 2nd and 3rd rate.  
Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, chinquapin, madrona, yew and dogwood.  
Undergrowth, vinemaple, rhododendron, salmonberry, salal, huckleberry, slickleaf, manzanita, willow, arrowwood, bracken and poison oak.

From the cor. of secs. 20, 21, 28 and 29

S. 89° 48' W., bet. secs. 20 and 29.

Asc. 24 ft. along top of ridge, through heavy dead timber and scattering green timber and dense undergrowth, in burn.

5.00 Foot trail, bears N. 89° E. and S. 89° W.

7.00 Leave top of ridge, bears E. and S. 75° W.; asc. 60 ft. over NE. slope.

16.70 Same ridge, divide bet. Smith River and Umpqua River, bears N. 20° W. and S. 20° E.; foot trail, bears N. 20° W. and S. 20° E.; desc. 400 ft. over broken W. slope.

35.50 A branch, 2 lks. wide, course S. 30° E.; asc. 125 ft. over NE. slope.

38.895 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for witness cor. to the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

39.145 The proportional point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. falls on steep insecure ground with bedrock about 4 ins. below the surface.

43.00 A spur, slopes SE.; asc. 200 ft. over broken SE. slope.

67.10 A ridge, divide bet. Smith River and Umpqua River, bears N. 85° E. and S. 15° W.; a foot trail, bears N. 85° E. and S. 15° W.; desc. 171 ft. over broken NW. slope.

77.20 A branch, 1 lk. wide, course N.; asc. 58 ft. over NE. slope.

78.29 The cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30.
