

Dependent Resurvey of Part of the Subdivision of
T. 21 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

- 7.80 A spur, slopes S. 60° E.; desc. 72 ft. over broken SW. slope.
- 22.00 A branch, 10 lks. wide, water in pools, course S. 60° E.; asc. 305 ft. over NE. slope.
- 33.00 Top of ascent on N. slope; desc. 6 ft. over broken N. slope.
- 36.70 A ravine, course N. 80° E.; asc. 337 ft. over dangerous SE. slope.
- 39.385 The proportional point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. falls on steep slope with about 2 ins. of loose soil.
- 43.115 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for witness cor. to the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

A dead fir, 70 ins. diam., bears N. 47° W., 103 lks. dist., mkd. W C $\frac{1}{4}$ S 17 B T.

A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears S. 27° E., 220 lks. dist., mkd. W C $\frac{1}{4}$ S 20 B T.

The witness cor. is located on top of a sharp spur ridge which bears N. and S.; desc. 398 ft. over broken W. slope.

- 53.00 A ravine, course SW.; desc. 261 ft. over broken SW. slope.
- 72.00 A branch, 3 lks. wide, course N. 85° W.; desc. 63 ft. over broken NW. slope.
- 78.77 The cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19 and 20.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, loose sandy and rocky loam, 1st, 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, chinquapin, madrona, yew, cherry, dogwood and cascara.

Undergrowth, vinemaple, rhododendron, salmonberry, salal, huckleberry, slickleaf, manzanita, hazel, willow, bracken, arrowwood, raspberry, thimbleberry, poison oak and Devil's club.

From the cor. of secs. 18 and 19, on the W. bdy. of the Tp., heretofore described,

S. 87° 34' E., bet. secs. 18 and 19.

Desc. 9 ft. over broken N. slope, through heavy dead timber and scattering green timber and dense undergrowth, in burn.

- 2.80 A spur, slopes NE.; desc. 245 ft. over SE. slope.
- 8.10 A ravine, course NE.; asc. 84 ft. over NW. slope.
- 12.80 A spur, slopes NE.; desc. 275 ft. over NE. slope, changing to E. slope.
- 18.10 A branch, 1 lk. wide, course NE.; asc. 66 ft. over NW. slope.
- 19.90 A spur, slopes N.; desc. 32 ft. over NE. slope.
- 21.20 A ravine, course NW.; asc. 270 ft. over NW. slope.
- 29.00 A spur ridge, bears NE. and SW.; desc. 443 ft. over broken SE. slope.
