42.30 Dry bed of creek, 3 lks. wide, course SE.; asc. 136 ft. over SW. slope.

48.70 A spur, slopes S.; desc. 48 ft. over SE. slope.

51.10 A ravine, course SW.; asc. 232 ft. over SW. slope.

56.50 A spur, slopes S.; desc. 68 ft. over SE. slope.

58.15 Proportional measurement.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

69.60 A spur, slopes S.; desc. 616 ft. over broken SE. slope.

82.40 Head of shallow ravine, course S.  $80^\circ$  E.

89.95 Big Creek Road, bears N.  $10^\circ$  E. and S.  $20^\circ$  W.

90.80 Big Creek, 15 lks. wide, course N.  $10^\circ$  E.; asc. 49 ft. over NW. slope.

97.64 The cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19 and 20.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, loose sandy and rocky loam, 1st, 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, chinquapin, madrona, yew, cherry, dogwood and cascara.

Undergrowth, vinemaple, rhododendron, salmonberry, salal, huckleberry, slickleaf, manzanita, willow, hazel, bracken, arrowwood, thimbleberry and poison oak.

N.  $0^\circ 54'$  E., bet. secs. 17 and 18.

Desc. 2 ft. over NW. slope, through heavy dead timber and scattering green timber and dense undergrowth, in burn.

0.40 A branch, 3 lks. wide, course W.; asc. 83 ft. over SW. slope.

7.50 A spur, slopes W.; desc. 104 ft. over NW. slope.

10.75 A ravine, course W.; asc. 19 ft. over SW. slope.

12.10 A spur, slopes W.; desc. 69 ft. over NW. slope.

14.10 A branch, 1 lk. wide, course W.; asc. 150 ft. over SW. slope.

25.50 A spur, slopes W.; desc. 88 ft. over NW. slope.

30.00 A ravine, course N.  $75^\circ$  W.; desc. 47 ft. over W. slope, changing to NW. slope.
