43.00 A spur, slopes N.  $60^{\circ}$  E.; desc. 498 ft. over broken N. slope.

57.00 A branch, 15 lks. wide, course E.; asc. 538 ft. over broken S.  
slope.

75.90 A spur ridge, bears E. and W.; desc. 115 ft. over NE. slope.

mkd. T 21 S R 8 W S 8 B T.

A dead fir, 50 ins. diam., bears S.  $16\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  W., 117 lks. dist.,  
mkd. T 21 S R 8 W S 7 B T.

A dead fir, 60 ins. diam., bears N.  $4^{\circ} 45'$  W., 114 lks. dist.,  
mkd. T 21 S R 8 W S 6 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, loose sandy and rocky loam, 1st, 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, chinquapin, madrona, yew,  
dogwood, cherry and cascara.

Undergrowth, vinemaple, salmonberry, rhododendron, salal, willow,  
huckleberry, hazel, arrowwood, manzanita, slickleaf, bracken and  
poison oak.

From the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9.

N.  $84^{\circ} 50'$  W., bet. secs. 5 and 8.

Asc. 230 ft. over NE. slope, through heavy dead timber and scatter-  
ing green timber and dense undergrowth, in burn.

9.00 A spur, slopes N.  $30^{\circ}$  W.; desc. 495 ft. over SW. slope.

24.50 A branch, 1 lk. wide, course N.  $75^{\circ}$  W.; over N. slope.

28.00 A spur, slopes NW.; desc. 94 ft. over NW. slope.
