

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of Subdivision of T 22 S, R 10 W

The closing cor. of secs. 21 and 22, the point for which is determined from the south bearing tree. The original stone cannot be found and the other two bearing trees, although still to be seen lying on the ground, are too badly decayed for identification.

At point for cor.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of secs. 21 and 22, with brass cap mkd.

Undergrowth, salmon berry, huckleberry, vine maple, rhododendron, salal, spirea, hazel, and Oregon grape.

An alder, 12 ins. diam., bears S 66° 00' E 21 lks. dist., blazed but with the marks destroyed by decay. (Old B.T.)

A fir, 26 ins. diam., bears S 68° 30' W, 28 lks. dist., mkd.
T 22 S R 10 W S 20 B T. (Old B.T. remarked on the overgrowth)

A fir, 38 ins. diam., bears S 23° 00' E 100 lks. dist., mkd.
T 22 S R 10 W S 21 B T (New B.T.)

A fallen alder, 15 ins. diam., bears N 33° 30' W 13 lks. dist. blazed but with the marks destroyed by decay. (Old B.T.)
