67.56	The witness $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 16 and 21, XXXXXXXXXXXX on S bank of Umpqu River. The bank bears approximately E and W and the river flows W. Thence in the river.
72.82	True point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 16 and 21, falls in the river. Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky, black loam; 3rd rate. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, and alder. Undergrowth, rhodendron, salmonberry, huckeberry, and salal.
