Subdivision of Sec. 21, T 22 S, R 10 W.

12.50	Stream, 2 lks. wide, course N 70° E; asc. 120 ft. over SE slope.
19.00	Spur, slopes NE; desc. 40 ft. over NW slope.
21.25	Point of intersection with the E and W center line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of <del>NE 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 16 and 21.</del> sec. 21. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground for NE 1/16 sec. cor., with brass cap mkd. NE 1/16 S 21 1936 from which A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N 80° 00' W, 30 lks. dist., mkd. NE 1/16 S 21 B T. An alder, 10 ins. diam., bears S 60° 00' E, 61 lks. dist., mkd. NE 1/16 S 21 B T. Desc. 700 ft. over precipitous NW slope.
37.75	Highway, bears N 76° 30' E and S 76° 30' W; thence over level bottom land.
38.91	The witness E 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 16 and 21. Thence in the Umpqua River which flows S 76° W.
41.59	Intersect the adjusted meander line of the left bank of the river at a point S 84° 17' W. 10.34 chs. dist. from the true point for the eastern meander cor. of frac. secs. 16 and 21.
42.50	True point for the E 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 16 and 21, falls in the river. Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky black loam; 3rd rate . Timber, fir, hemlock, alder and maple. Undergrowth, rhododendron, vine maple, salmon berry, and huckleberry.
	From the center N 1/16 sec. cor. of sec. 21. S 88° 53' E on true line through the center of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 21. Asc. 100 ft. over W slope, through heavy timber and dense Undergrowth.
2.25	Spur, slopes N; desc. 240 ft. over E slope.
8.30	Draw, course N 30° E; asc. 70 ft. over NW slope.
13.70	Spur, slopes N 20° E; desc. 120 ft. over NE slope.
16.90	Stream, 1 lk. wide, course N; asc. 165 ft. over NW slope.
20.56	The NE 1/16 sec. cor. of sec. 21. Asc. 25 ft. over NW slope.
22.30	Spur, slopes N 30° E; desc. 200 ft. over E slope.
29.25	Creek, 5 lks. wide, course N 20° E; asc. 160 ft. over NW slope.
33.65	Spur, slopes N; desc. 50 ft. over NE slope.
35.65	Draw, course N 20° E; thence along broken N slope.
39.50	Draw, course NW; asc. 110 ft. over W slope changing to NW slope.
41.13	The N 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 21 and 22. Undergrowth, rhododendron, salmon berry, huckleberry, and vine maple. Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky black loam; 3rd rate. Timber, fir, hemlock cedar, maple and alder.
