A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S. 62°45' E., 73 lks. dist.,  
mkd. T 24 S R 3 W S 7 BT.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy clay loam.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, madrona, chinquapin and dogwood; undergrowth, vinemaple, arrowwood, willow, hazel, salal, bracken, thimbleberry and huckleberry.

N. 3°00' E., along the W. bdy. of sec. 6.

Asc. 57 ft. over SE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

6.21 Point for closing cor. of secs. 1 and 12, T. 24 S., R. 4 W.; at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Asc. 16½ ft. over SE. slope, changing to SW. slope.

15.10 A spur, slopes W.; desc. 23 ft. over NW. slope.

18.70 A ravine, course W.; asc. 65 ft. over SW. slope.

32.30 Harness Mountain Trail, bears N. 36° W. and S. 36° E.

33.20 A ridge (divide bet. Oldham Creek and Coon Creek), bears N. 35° W. and S. 35° E.; desc. 1 ft. over broken E. slope.

39.39 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 6; at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original ¼ sec. cor.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
