

DEPENDENT RESURVEY, W. BDY., T. 24 S., R. 3 W.

CHAINS

An incense cedar, 33 ins. diam., bears S. 9° E., 636 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 6 BT.

The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. is located on a spur, slopes S. 70° E.; desc. 37 ft. over broken NE. slope.

45.50 A branch, 2 lks. wide, course SE.; asc. 4 ft. over S. slope.

46.04 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 1, T. 24 S., R. 4 W., at proportionate distance.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

49.80 A spur, slopes E.; desc. 16 ft. over N. slope.

51.85 A ravine, course S. 80° E.; asc. 25 ft. over SE. slope.

56.50 A branch, 4 lks. wide, course E.; asc. 154 ft. over S. slope, changing to SW. slope.

67.50 Top of ascent on W. slope; desc. 4 ft. over NW. slope.

68.70 A branch, 3 lks. wide, course S. 60° W.; asc. 22 ft. over SE. slope.

73.70 A small spur, slopes SW.; desc. 4 ft. over NW. slope.

74.10 A branch, 4 lks. wide, course SW.; asc. 149 ft. over broken S. slope.

80.82 Point for the closing cor. of Tps. 24 S., Rs. 3 and 4 W., at proportionate distance on the S. bdy. of sec. 31, T. 23 S., R. 3 W.; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A cedar, 7 ins. diam., bears S. 43 1/4° W., 82 lks. dist., mkd. T 24 S R 4 W S 1 CC BT.

From this point the SW. cor. of T. 23 S., R. 3 W., bears N. 89° 55' W., 3.60 chs. dist., heretofore described.

This closing corner is located on a small spur, slopes E.
