

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISION OF T. 24 S., R. 3 W.

CHAINS

- 62.80 A graded graveled logging road, bears N. 7° W. and S. 7° E.
- 67.60 A spur, slopes S. 75° E.; desc. 23 ft. over SW. slope.
- 70.35 A ravine, course S.; asc. 101 ft. over SE. slope.
- 76.85 The cor. of secs. 16, 17, 20 and 21.

Land, mountainous and rolling.
 Soil, heavy sandy clay loam.
 Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, madrona, chinquapin, yew and dogwood; undergrowth, slickleaf, vinemaple, manzanita, bracken, willow, hazel, arrowwood, thimbleberry and salmonberry.

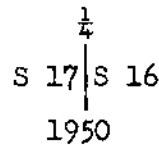
N. 2°01' E., bet. secs. 16 and 17.

Asc. 69 ft. over SE. slope; through heavy timber and dense undergrowth, in logged area.

- 15.70 A spur, slopes E.; Pete Gray's house Bears N. 61°45' E.; desc. 109 ft. over NE. slope.
- 19.30 A branch, 2 lks. wide, course E.; asc. 151 ft. over SE. slope.
- 28.00 A spur, slopes E.; desc. 33 ft. over NE. slope.
- 29.30 A branch, 1 lk. wide, course E.; asc. 73 ft. over SE. slope.
- 39.825 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 16 and 17, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

- 52.55 A branch, 4 lks. wide, course S. 70° E.; asc. 305 ft. over SE. slope.
- 72.10 A spur, slopes S. 80° E.; desc. 3 ft. over NE. slope.
- 72.80 A ravine, course S. 60° E.; asc. 21 ft. over SE. slope.
- 74.10 A spur, slopes E.; desc. 27 ft. over NE. slope.
- 76.00 A ravine, course E.; asc. 37 ft. over SE. slope.
