DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISION OF T. 24 S., R. 3 W.

Point for the cor. of secs. 8, 9, 16 and 17, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 12 ins. in the ground, to bedrock, and in a mound of stone, .4 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.

The sec. cor. is located at the head of a small spur, slopes NE.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, heavy sandy clay loam.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, chinquapin, madrona, yew and dogwood; undergrowth, vinemaple, slickleaf, manzanita, bracken, willow, hazel, arrowwood, salal, salmonberry and thimbleberry.

The cor. of secs. 9, 10, 15 and 16 is monumented with a badly decayed cedar post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., on which no marks remain; from which the original bearing trees:

A fir stub, 40 ins. diam., bears N. 13½° E., 18 lks. dist.,
mkd. on bark T 24 S R 3 W S 10 BT. (Record bearing N. 11° E.)

An incense cedar, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 68° E., 7 lks. dist.,
with partial scribe marks visible on partially healed old blaze. (Record bearing S. 70° E.)

An incense cedar, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 62½° W., 44 lks. dist.,
with partial scribe marks visible on partially healed old blaze. (Record S. 60° W., 50 lks. dist.)

A fir stub, 22 ins. diam., bears N. 73½° W., 30 lks. dist.,
mkd. T 24 S R 3 W S 9 BT. (Record bearing N. 70° W.)

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with remains of decayed cedar post deposited at the base, with brass cap mkd.
