

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISION OF T. 24 S., R. 3 W.

from which

A hemlock, 20 ins. diam., bears N. $45\frac{1}{2}^\circ$ E., 69 lks. dist., mkd. T 24 S R 3 W S 3 BT.

A yew, 6 ins. diam., bears S. $9^\circ 45'$ E., 54 lks. dist., mkd. T 24 S R 3 W S 10 BT.

A hemlock, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 68° W., 20 lks. dist., mkd. T 24 S R 3 W S 9 BT.

A hemlock, 20 ins. diam., bears N. $47\frac{1}{2}^\circ$ W., 44 lks. dist., mkd. T 24 S R 3 W S 4 BT.

The sec. cor. is located on top of a mound of earth up-turned by the roots of a fallen tree.

S. $86^\circ 39'$ W., bet. secs. 4 and 9.

Desc. 18 ft. along broken N. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

7.20 A spur, slopes NW.; desc. 176 ft. over broken W. slope.

14.00 Coon Creek, 40 lks. wide, course S. 30° W.; asc. 423 ft. over broken SE. slope.

15.10 A dirt logging road, bears N. 30° E. and S. 30° W.

29.45 A spur, slopes S.; desc. 121 ft. over SW. slope.

38.45 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 9, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining trace of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 26 ins. diam., bears N. $41^\circ 45'$ E., 27 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 4 BT.

A hemlock, 18 ins. diam., bears S. $29\frac{1}{2}^\circ$ W., 77 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 9 BT.

Desc. 26 ft. over SW. slope.

39.30 A branch, 2 lks. wide, course S.; asc. 298 ft. over broken E. slope.

47.20 A spur, slopes S. 10° E.; desc. 131 ft. over SW. slope.

54.35 A ravine, course S.; asc. 98 ft. over SE. slope.

57.60 A spur, slopes S.; desc. 363 ft. over SW. slope.

70.65 A branch, 4 lks. wide, course S. 30° E.; asc. 136 ft. over NE. slope.

76.90 The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9.

Land, mountainous.
Soil, heavy sandy clay loam.
